

MAPS 4 Transit Planned Growth

MAPS 4 includes **\$61.3 million** to implement two additional BRT corridors located in the study areas shown on the map.

Timeline

MAPS 4 anticipates opening date to be in Summer 2028 for the Northeast Corridor, and Summer 2029 for the South Corridor.











